CLINICIAN OF THE YEAR

Kevin T. Geraci, MD

Partner, University Hospital Medical Practice Gastroenterology

Clinician of the Year is more than just another accolade. It's an extremely high honor bestowed upon a worthy clinician that has been carefully selected by his/her peers. Recognized by his colleagues for his long-time devotion and service to his patients, Dr. Geraci exemplifies the highest ideals and ethics of the medical profession. Dr. Geraci has been very active at the AMCNO over the years through his work on various committees. He currently serves as a member of the Membership Committee and he is a previous member of the AMCNO Board of Directors. Dr. Geraci served as president of the AMCNO in 2002-2003 and he currently serves as a member of the Academy of Medicine Education Foundation (AMEF) board. Dr. Geraci received his undergraduate degree from The College of the Holy Cross, Worcester, Massachusetts, and his medical degree from The Ohio State University College of Medicine. After completing a medical internship at University Hospitals in Columbus, he served in the United States Navy during the Vietnam War and was discharged as a Lieutenant Commander. After the service, Dr. Geraci returned to Cleveland and completed his residency in internal medicine and a fellowship in gastroenterology at University Hospitals of Cleveland. Following his fellowship, he became director of the Division of Gastroenterology at St. Luke's Hospital teaching both there and at University Hospital as an Associate Professor of Medicine. He presently is Clinical Professor of Medicine at the Case Western Reserve University School of Medicine and is a partner in the University Hospital Medical Practice Gastroenterology. He is a member of several national medical societies and was a recipient of the Premier Physician Award from the National Foundation for Ileitis and Colitis. He is on the staff at University Hospitals and is a consulting gastroenterologist in the University Hospitals System.
